To Whom It May Concern:

Under the Authority of Louisiana Revised Statute 46:337.18A.(4) the Administrator of the Lincoln Parish Sales and Use Tax Commission is granting a thirty (30) day extension to file or make payments for sales and use tax returns due September 20, 2005. This extension applies only to those businesses located in the following parishes: Orleans, Jefferson, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Tammany and Washington.

Businesses required to file with this parish that are located in any of the other areas declared a federal disaster area may also request in writing a thirty (30) day extension of time to file sales and use tax returns due September 20, 2005.

Such authorization also permits the Administrator to waive the imposition of delinquent penalties for late filing insofar as the delinquency is attributed solely to the inability of the business to meet its filing responsibility because of consequences arising from Hurricane Katrina.
